

MILITARY and VETERAN ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

	s checklist is a guide to assist you in completing the enrollment process at Northeast Iowa Community College and eiving educational benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs.
	Apply online at www.nicc.edu/apply.
	Submit high school and previous college transcripts.
	Request Official Military Transcripts and submit to admissions@nicc.edu. Air Force members request transcripts from www.airuniversity.af.edu/Barnes/CCAF/FAQs. All other branches request your transcripts at jst.doded.mil/jst.
	Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov to qualify for additional student aid.
	Register with an advisor and contact School Certifying Official to let them know you have enrolled and if you will b using and education benefits.
	Certify your attendance on the last day of each month for Chapters 30 and Chapter 1606 by calling 844.823.2378 (automated) or 888.442.4551 (live person). For Chapter 33 call 888.442.4551 or choose the VA's Opt-In feature to receive a text message each month prompting you to verify your enrollment status.
	Complete the ACCUPLACER® Reading and Writing assessment and ALEKS® Math assessment. Assessments may be waived based on appropriate previous college coursework, a transcript may be submitted in lieu of testing. We also accept your ACT®, SAT®, Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) scores.

	Apply online at www.va.gov/education/how-to-apply.
	If you are using tuition assistance, contact your Education Service Officer (ESO) or counselor within your branch of service. Once your tuition assistance has been approved, send proof of approval to the School Certifying Official.
	Once you apply for benefits, you will receive a Certificate of Eligibility letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs. You must submit a copy of this form to the School Certifying Official.
	Submit a copy of your DD-214 or DD Form 2384 (Notice of Basic Eligibility – NOBE) and a copy of your College Func (Kicker) contract, if eligible, to the School Certifying Office. *Dependents do not submit a copy of the DD 214 but must have the veteran's social security number or VA file number to apply for benefits.
	Complete the NICC Veterans Worksheet in Student Eforms.
