Research transfer scholarships and consider joining Phi Theta Kappa (PTK).	
	TK is the official academic honor society for two-year colleges. You are eligible to join PTK if you have earned 2 college credits and have a cumulative GPA of 3.5. Many transfer colleges offer great scholarships to PTK members!
