That's an advantage Brennan Booth gained as a City of Peosta employee. Now a full-time public works operator for the City, Brennan was hired after completing the NICC Building Construction - Career Pathway Certificate program. He enrolled in the program in 2022 and developed his skills in construction and heavy equipment operation using a mini excavator, dump truck, front end loader and skid loader. Thanks to local industry and donor support, Brennan received his career training at no cost.

The City also encouraged Brennan to earn his Commercial Driver License / Semi-Truck Driving certification at the College. Thanks to community development and your local support, he graduated last spring and is a more versatile employee.

"I'm still learning things in my public works position and in the future I may enroll in an online engineering program so I can stay local. Working as a city engineer would be an amazing opportunity," Brennan said.
