Beyond rumpers Your Role in Student Success

Can you imagine the weight lifted when a financial hurdle, a sudden car repair, or an unexpected childcare cost no longer threatens to derail your dreams?

For the 48% of students at Northeast Iowa Community College who reported not knowing where to find \$500 in the case of an emergency, your support of Annual and Endowed Scholarships and the Student Support Fund has been a lifeline to success, lifting that weight from a student's shoulders.

This past fall, your gifts supported 27 students at NICC who felt financial relief thanks to the Student Support Fund. \$10,380 was awarded, with an average award of \$384.44. These funds have acted as a bridge, keeping students on track and focused on their education, especially those looking to graduate this May.

This vital support is only one of the ways your donations are making a difference. Your generosity also provided meaningful scholarship support to 392 out of 871 student applicants.

Across the NICC district, the demand for scholarship support is clear. With over \$325,000 in scholarship dollars awarded, students on average received \$833. For a student at NICC, these scholarships aren't just numbers; they represent the ability to purchase textbooks, cover tuition gaps and reduce the stress affecting academic progress.

Your gift has extended far beyond financial support for a student. Think of the single parent, returning student, or young adult navigating their first year – each represents a story that your support has helped write. It has ensured a student can stay enrolled, reach academic milestones, graduate and successfully enter our local workforce.


"Nursing has more textbooks, more equipment, more lab kits, more fees than some other programs, and, with living outside of Iowa, the scholarships really help take off some of the financial burden. The financial stress can be a tipping point, whether you decide to go ahead with college or not. I am grateful for the opportunity to have the funding of a scholarship. Some might not realize the difference that it makes in other people's lives. It has allowed me to continue my education to go after my dream," Sydney said.

Sydney's mother, Amy, is also enrolled in Nursing. Amy's return to school after 23 years was made possible, in part, by scholarships provided by generous donors. Amy shared, "Scholarships really help take off some of the financial burden from the extra fees on top of program costs, and also traveling from out-of-state. Have you ever watched a block of metal turn into a functional piece of equipment with just a few lines of code? Neither had Brandon, until he started at Northeast Iowa Community College last fall. Because of you, Brandon has been able to follow his dreams, learn valuable skills and find a good job in a local community.

Last year, Brandon, a current Computer Numerical Control (CNC) Machinist Technician student, was looking for a fresh start. He chose NICC because it was close to home and was well-known for its technical programs. Like many students, he worried about how to balance school, work and family.

Your generosity has helped shape Brandon's success here at NICC. The multiple scholarships and financial aid he has received during his time at NICC allowed him to focus on his education without overwhelming financial stress.

Brandon's journey began at the NC3 National Career & Technical Education Letter of Intent Signing Day last April, where he met his future instructor and connected with other students pursuing technical careers. It was here that he also received his first scholarship, sponsored by a local business, to assist him with school-related expenses.

Initially, Brandon was nervous about starting at NICC. He felt like he had barely passed high school, and wasn't sure if college would be a good fit for him. Despite his fears, Brandon took a chance on the CNC program knowing that he enjoyed working on machines.

With your support, Brandon has thrived at NICC in and out of the classroom.

One of the biggest surprises for Brandon at NICC was making close friends in the CNC program and joining the Esports team. Brandon also emphasized, "Our instructor is really amazing. He goes above and beyond to help me and other students in the classroom with labs and projects."

As Brandon is on track to graduate this summer, he is already considering his next steps. After connecting with a local employer at an NICC-sponsored job fair, he secured a parttime job with the company this semester and will transition into a full-time role after graduation this summer.
