



2+2 Criminal Justice Transfer Plan

Students who complete the coursework outlined in this plan and earn the NICC AA degree with a 2.5 cumulative grade point average will be offered admission to the college and have the opportunity to graduate with a BA in Criminal Justice within two calendar years. Students must earn a C (2.0) or better in all NICC coursework in order for the course to transfer to Loras College. Students may transfer a maximum of 64 credits earned at any two year institution.

Students must maintain a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative grade point average in all Loras College required and elective courses for the criminal justice major. No criminal justice coursework taken at another school shall be applied to their major program requirements once they have enrolled. **Students participating in this transfer program will be required to complete one January Term course at Loras College.**
