University of Wisconsin-Platteville Bachelor of Science Degree: Elementary Education/Early Childhood, Department of Education

Northeast Iowa Community College Diploma Program: Early Childhood

Overview:

This formal course articulation agreement is made and entered into by Northeast Iowa Community College and University of Wisconsin-Platteville. By this agreement Northeast Iowa Community College and University of Wisconsin-Platteville express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access and success in higher education.

Purpose:

This agreement provides a transfer course template for Early Childhood students at Northeast Iowa Community College to transfer to the Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education/Early Childhood at University of Wisconsin-Platteville.

This agreement is based on an analysis of the program requirements as stated in the Northeast Iowa Community College 2016 catalog and the major and degree requirements as stated in the 2014-2016 University of Wisconsin-Platteville catalog. It is understood that this agreement will be reviewed and, if necessary, modified when either institution issues a new catalog or alters the program/major requirements.
