## Responsibilities

- Oversee, recruit and retain CAT team members
- Prepare agendas for and lead CAT team meetings
- Assist with CAT events
- Attend leadership trainings
- Assist with new student orientations
- Assist Admissions Reps with prospective students, including tours and visit days
- Serve on campus committees as a voice of the student body



## Qualifications

- Enrolled in a minimum of nine (9) credit hours
- Completed a FAFSA for the academic year of enrollment
- Maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Responsible and dependable
- Works well with others



## Compensation

- Work approximately 10 hours (\$12/hr.) per week
- **Start Date:** Early August
- **End Date:** Mid-May (End of the Spring semester)
- Additional stipend of \$100 available
